VIDYA SHIKSHA KENDRA - A RURAL LITERACY CENTRE

- Vidya Shiksha Kendra is an innovative project for Adivasi and rural children living in and around Bamunara village in Bardhaman District in West Bengal.
- The children and young adults there have had no access to any educational facilities or indigenous tools for improving intelligence skills. Recognizing knowledge and mentoring is the most powerful vehicle for self-empowerment, the Vidya Shiksha Kendra has established A Rural Literacy Centre and A Rural Children Library to facilitate their educational programs.



- For the past five years, the Shri Kunja has been running a free informal tuition-cum-study center in a mud-hut; then in an open shed with an asbestos sheet. The center will now have a prefabricated school building established by Tata Blue Scope, Pune, to fulfill its long standing vision.

A RURAL CHILDREN LIBRARY (RCL)

Located in the natural sprawling landscape of Shri Kunja the Rural Children Library (RCL) provides a reading and study place to children and young minds.

The Library Collection

The Rural Children Library (RCL) is a treasure trove of knowledge on a variety of children's literature ranging from school books prescribed by the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education (WBBSE) and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) to easy-to-read story books, picture books, alphabetical books, counting books, wordless books, magazines, poems, classical and world literature, spiritual literature, and conceptually framed encyclopedias on the arts, sciences, and biographies in English, Hindi, and Bengali.
